Working both within and against the constraints they imposed, Booker T. Washington developed a pedagogy in which literature and art were permissible only if they were directly related to vocational training for low-status work. W.E.B. Du Bois famously objected, calling for an aesthetic education that would develop black youths' critical social consciousness, but Washington largely prevailed in the public schools.

Formal art education emerged in the United Kingdom in the early 19th century, motivated in part

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by a desire to match the quality of design work being done in France. The model initially adopted was that of the German commercial schools. Prince Albert was particularly influential in the creation of schools of Art in the UK.
