Article XII of the WTO Agreement states that accession to the WTO will be “on terms to be agreed” between the acceding government and the WTO.

Accession to the WTO is essentially a process of negotiation — quite different from the process of accession to other international entities, like the IMF, which is largely an automatic process.

Accession shall take place by deposit with the Director-General of the WTO of an instrument of accession that states the terms so agreed. This Agreement shall enter into force for a Member acceding to it on the 30th day following the deposit of its instrument of accession. Reservations

The most common is to benefit from its integration into the global trading system, and WTO membership is considered the entry point for such integration. Once it has acceded to the Organization, the country can participate, on an equal footing with other members, in negotiations on future trade rules in WTO.
