An amino acid sequence is simply the order of these units in a polypeptide chain. In the case of proteins, the sequence determines the molecule's three-dimensional structure, which in turn is crucial to the protein's function. The sequences of amino acids in the proteins found in a living organism are coded in that organism's DNA.

Protein primary structure is the linear sequence of amino acids in a peptide or protein. By convention, the primary structure of a protein is reported starting from the amino-terminal (N) end to the carboxyl-terminal (C) end. Protein biosynthesis is most commonly performed by ribosomes in cells.

An amino acid sequence is the order in which various acids get linked to form a protein or a peptide chain. A peptide chain is a long covalently-bonded chain of acids. If a peptide chain, happens to be a protein, its alignment sequence is called its 'Primary Structure'. Branched chain amino acids form all the proteins of the human body.
