Follow directions provided for each exam technique. Scores should reflect what the patient does, not what the clinician thinks the patient can do.

The National Institutes of Health Stroke Scale (NIHSS) was developed in 1989 1, and modified later 2 in order to effectively document and standardize the clinical severity of strokes for use in multicenter clinical trials.

The answer must be correct - there is no partial credit for being close. Aphasic and stuporous patients who do not comprehend the questions will score 2. Patients unable to speak because of endotracheal intubation, orotracheal trauma, severe dysarthria from any cause, language barrier, or any other problem not secondary to aphasia are given a 1.

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NIH Stroke Scale/Score (NIHSS) - MDCalc

The National Institutes of Health Stroke Scale (NIHSS) is a score calculated from 11 components and is used to quantify the severity of strokes. The 11 components are: level of consciousness (1a: 0-3, 1b: 0-2 and 1c: 0-2) best gaze (0-2) visual fields (0-3) facial palsy (0-3) arm motor (0-4) leg motor (0-4)

NIH Stroke Scale/Score (NIHSS) The NIH Stroke Scale has many caveats buried within it. If your patient has prior known neurologic deficits e.g. prior weakness, hemi- or quadriplegia, blindness, etc. or is intubated, has a language barrier, etc., it becomes especially complicated. In those cases, consult the NIH Stroke Scale website.

If a patient has an isolated peripheral nerve paresis (CN III, IV or VI) score a 1. Gaze is testable in all aphasic patients.
