"By law, slaves were the personal property of their owners in all Southern states except Louisiana. The slave master held absolute authority over his human property as the Louisiana law made clear: "The master may sell him, dispose of his person, his industry,

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and his labor; [the slave] can do nothing, possess nothing, nor acquire anything but what must belong to his master.”
