But if your baby is breech, it means he's poised to come out buttocks or feet first. When labor begins at 37 weeks or later, nearly 97 percent of babies are set to come out headfirst. Most of the rest are breech. (In rare cases, a baby will be sideways in the uterus with his shoulder, back, or arm presenting first - this is called a transverse lie.)

Factors that increase the likelihood of a breech baby are: Prematurity. Twins or multiples. High levels of amniotic fluid. The birthing person has an abnormally shaped uterus. But, there are a lot of other reasons why a baby can be breech and a lot of safe things you can do to flip that baby head down.

In a breech birth, the baby's head is the last part of its body to emerge making it more difficult to ease it through the birth canal. Sometimes forceps are used to guide the baby's head out of the birth canal. Another potential problem is cord prolapse.

What Sleeping Position Will Help Turn My Breech Baby?

Diagnosing a breech baby In the weeks before your due date, your doctor or midwife will determine your baby's position by feeling the outside of your abdomen and uterus with her hands. If your baby is breech, her round and firm head will be toward the top of your uterus and her softer and less round bottom will be lower in your uterus.

Webster Technique is a specific sacral adjustment used to help promote pelvic alignment and balance in the nervous system. This adjustment creates balance in your pelvis to allow for a breech-positioned baby to flip for optimal birth positioning. It realigns the sacrum, which releases the pull and tension in your uterus.

The baby is full-term (at least 37 weeks gestation), although in practice preterm babies sometimes come very quickly and are born uneventfully in the breech presentation before a cesarean can be done. The baby is frank or complete breech presentation. The baby does not show signs of distress while its heart rate is closely monitored.

Breech Birth: What Are Your Options for Delivery?

While about 30 per cent of babies are breech at 30-32 weeks, only 3 per cent are still breech at term (37 weeks), says OB-GYN Ellen Giesbrecht, a doctor at BC Women's Hospital in Vancouver. You may have also heard that yoga positions, swimming, belly dancing, spending time upside down, or doing exercises like pelvic tilts can help.

If your baby is lying bottom or feet first,
