Cattell Culture Fair Intelligence Test

The Culture Fair Intelligence Test was created by Raymond Cattell in 1949 as an attempt to measure cognitive abilities devoid of sociocultural and environmental influences. Scholars have subsequently concluded that the attempt to construct measures of cognitive abilities devoid of the influences of experiential and cultural conditioning is a challenging one. Cattell proposed that general intelligence comprises both Fluid Intelligence and Crystallized Intelligence. Whereas Gf is biologically and

Cattell argued that general intelligence (g) exists and that it consists of fluid intelligence and crystallized intelligence.
