Chapter 1 Introduction To Pathophysiology

Chapter 1: Introduction to Pathophysiology. Occurs when one mature cell type is replaced by another mature cell type; May result from Vit. A deficiency; or may result as an adaptive mechanism when a stronger cell replaces a weaker cell; Ex: when stratified squamous cells replace ciliated columnar in the respiratory system in cigarette smokers as a defense mechanism.
