These federal acts and related state laws invalidate property restrictions and local laws that discriminate or disenfranchise Americans on the basis of race, religious faith, gender, familial status, or disability.

Their Constitution and Bill of Rights protected property in many ways: * The Founders were worried that Congress might use the tax system to loot property owners in some states for the advantage of other states. Accordingly, they required that direct taxes (mostly importantly property and income taxes) be apportioned among the states (Article I, Section 2, Clause 3 and Article I, Section 9, Clause 4).

Another provision related to property rights is the Constitution's prohibition against any state law "impairing the Obligation of Contracts." On its face, this provision - which appears in Article I of the Constitution's main text - would seem to prohibit any law that impairs a person's contractual right to acquire or use property.
