Thus in general, simply not using the hand will not fix the problem (at least not in a reasonable time period.) The most common tendon to be injured is the superficial digital flexor tendon, usually in the cannon region. While galloping, the fetlock joint sinks significantly, which is when the strain through this tendon is
