France enters the war in 1778. Cause: France wants to weaken its enemy Britain. Effect: Combined forces result in victory for the Americans. By approving the Articles of Confederation, states create a weak national government. Cause: States need a plan for a national government but want to protect their own authority.

A Olive Branch Petition. The petition was written by John Dickinson of Pennsylvania and approved by the Second Continental Congress in July of 1775. The document told King George III that the colonists were loyal to him and asked him to respond to their complaints. However, he declared the colonists in rebellion on August 23, 1775.
