The bio-psycho-social model assumes that mental health problems are hardly ever limited to just one domain of human experience (say, just a "mental" problem). Instead, most mental health problems are influenced by multiple domains of human experience, and have biological (medical), psychological (mental) and social/spiritual impacts.

The Biopsychosocial Perspective The interaction of biological, psychological, and social aspects of developmental psychology form the essence of the holistic biopsychosocial perspective. The biopsychosocial perspective attributes complex phenomena or events to multiple causes.

Health psychology examines the reciprocal influences of biology, psychology, behavioral, and social factors on health and illness. One specific application of the biopsychosocial model within health and medicine relates to pain, such that several factors outside an individual's health may affect their perception of pain.
