The full name for a hypo is hypoglycaemia. It's when your blood glucose level (also called blood sugar) is too low, usually below 4mmol/l. This can happen if the balance of diabetes medication you take (especially insulin), food you eat and physical activity you do sometimes isn't right.

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In the case of low blood glucose levels, it is generally only people on certain medications such as insulin and tablets which directly stimulate insulin production that need to be actively aware of low blood sugar symptoms. Hypos can also occur while sleeping, which may wake you up during the night or cause headaches, tiredness or damp sheets (from sweat) in the morning. If you have a device to check your blood sugar level, a reading of less than 4mmol/L is too low and should be treated.

The treatment for night time hypos is the same as the general advice for treating hypos That is to take 10 to 15g of a quick acting sugary food (such as sweets or glucose tablets) and some slower acting carbohydrate such as a slice of bread to prevent a further hypo taking place.

The question ("can I have low blood sugar with type 2 diabetes?") is very common, and it's easy to see why it's of concern.

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This is because high blood glucose in the long term is linked to damage to your kidneys, eyes, nerves, feet and heart. However, keeping tight control of your blood glucose does increase the risk of hypos. Having said that, there are lots of steps you can take to reduce the risk of hypos. These include: Not skipping or delaying snacks or meals.

What makes the counter-regulatory response so hard to deal with for Type 2s--and what adds to the confusion about the danger of hypos--is that the body does not have a set, absolute threshold for

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responding to perceived hypos. It does not say to itself, "Uh-oh, blood sugar approaching 55, time to do Hypo Repair!".

Hypers. The full name for a hyper is hyperglycaemia. This happens when your blood glucose levels are too high - usually above 7mmol/l before a meal and above 8.5mmol/l two hours after a meal. There are several reasons why this may happen. It may be that you:
