Keep the introduction brief. Use the word "you" at least once. Dedicate 1-2 sentences to articulating what the article covers. Dedicate 1-2 sentences to explaining why the article is important.

Start with a great first sentence. These sentences should also set the stage for your thesis statement. The thesis statement is the subject of much instruction and training. The entirety of your paper hangs on that sentence, which is generally the last sentence of your introductory paragraph.

To write an introduction, be mindful of what it's supposed to achieve. The main goals here are to draw in your reader -- a relative stranger, most of the time -- and concisely let her know what the article is about. The purpose of a good introduction in a formal presentation is to achieve three goals: Grasp the audience's attention. Identify the topic and the purpose or core message of the talk. Provide a brief overview or agenda of what you will cover in the talk.

Use the first paragraph to introduce yourself, the second for your request, and the third to thank the reader for his or her consideration. Use a simple font. Use a simple font (like Calibri, Times New Roman, or Arial) and a font size that is easy to read. An 11 or 12-point font size is readable without having to squint.

Stick closely to your outline for the paper, and structure your introduction in a similar way. The entire introduction should logically end at the research question and thesis statement or hypothesis. The reader, by the end of the introduction, should know exactly what you are trying to achieve with the paper.

Write a Great First Sentence and Introductory Paragraph

Do try drafting the rest of your article before working on the introduction. Often, writing a piece will reveal the best way to introduce it. If your intro doesn't flow from the beginning, start with a placeholder and write the opening paragraph after the article is complete. Take time craft and carefully edit your introduction.

It is polite to start with a warm welcome and to introduce yourself. Everyone in the audience will want to know who you are. Your introduction should include your name and job position or the reason you are an expert on your topic. The more the audience trusts you, the more they listen.

13 Engaging Ways to Begin an Essay

Keep your introduction short and simple. Generally, your introduction should be between 5 and 10 percent of the overall length of your essay. If you're writing a 10-page paper, your introduction should be approximately 1 page. For shorter essays under 1,000 words, keep your introduction to 1 paragraph, between 100 and 200 words.
