What is proficiency testing? Proficiency testing, or PT, is the testing of unknown samples sent to a laboratory by an . HHS-approved PT program. Most sets of PT samples are sent to participating laboratories on a scheduled basis (usually three times per year). After testing, the laboratory reports its sample results back to their PT program.

Laboratories applying for or holding a New York State (NYS) clinical laboratory permit must participate in proficiency testing (PT) as defined by NYS (NYS mandated PT). NYS mandated PT includes all tests/analytes offered by the laboratory that are either listed in CMS 42 CFR 493 subpart I (CLIA subpart I) OR defined by NYS as requiring PT. Proficiency testing (PT), mandated by Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) '88, is a source of external quality control. This practice of testing unknown specimens from an outside source provides an additional means to assure quality laboratory testing results.

Laboratory Quality Assurance Proficiency Testing ...

- Distribute proficiency panels and questionnaires to participating laboratories to determine the ability of laboratories to provide valid SARS-CoV diagnostics.
- Provide guidance on laboratory safety for SARS-CoV and other respiratory diagnostic testing and for possible SARS-CoV-containing specimens submitted for other tests.

Proficiency Testing Multiple Kits • One PT result per analyte per type of specimen (serum, whole blood, urine, etc.) is allowed for each individual CLIA -licensed laboratory. • If a laboratory routinely uses more than one primary method/instrument for reporting the same analyte, PT can be rotated among the primary methods/instruments. •
