Overview of the Logical Framework Approach • Log frame matrix, a documented product of the LFA is prepared before a project proposal and makes its integral part. • The two Main Stages of Logical Framework Approach: 1. Logical Framework Analysis - SSWM

The LFA method (Logical Framework Analysis) is the fundamental tool of Project Cycle Management (PCM) and Results-Based Management (RBM). LFA is step-by-step procedure applying specific techniques in a participatory workshop setting for gathering a thorough picture of a problematic situation as perceived from different perspectives (stakeholders).
