Treatment of Mud Fever in Horses Once your equine is diagnosed with mud fever the veterinarian will recommend keeping the horse in a clean and dry stall. The horse will be placed on stall rest and should not be allowed to be left in damp or wet conditions.

In the case of a high fever, or a low fever that's causing discomfort, your doctor may recommend an over-the-counter medication, such as acetaminophen (Tylenol, others) or ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin IB, others). Use these medications according to the label instructions or as recommended by your doctor. Be careful to avoid taking too much.

Although this does involve bandaging and stabling the horse, it is a very effective treatment. Certain cases of mud fever may $\frac{Page}{P}$

require systemic antibiotics. These treatments contain prescription only medications, so a veterinarian will need to see your horse to assess which treatment option is most suited to your horse.

Can Diet Prevent Scratches in Horses? - The Horse

Prevention is preferable and keeping your horses' legs clean and dry is the best way to control mud fever. However, this is easier said than done at this time of year. Clipping very hairy legs will reduce the accumulation of wet mud around the lower limb and allow better assessment for developing lesions.
