Nehemiah teaches us that building something great for God requires 4 things: 1) Compelling Reason iV v4a iV look at the heart of Nehemiah here iV iti;s broken. Nehemiah is about to set out on a quest to rebuild and repopulate Jerusalem.

Building For God Part 3: Preparation For ... - Preach The Word

Nehemiah knew that God would recognize his efforts. He was laboring to hear "well done" from the Lord (13:31). (2) A leader must motivate people. The Jews had been back in the land for 90 years, but the wall hadn't been built. But then Nehemiah came along and got everyone excited about the idea.

When the enemies of God's people heard that the walls were being rebuilt and the breaches (openings) closed up, they were furious. So the enemies of God came "TO HINDER" (Nehemiah 4:8) the work of God. The builders of the wall could have easily stopped building and instead gone to fight the enemies of God's work; but they stayed the course.

Nehemiah knew that God had not given Shemaiah this message. Sanballat and Tobiah hired him to cause Nehemiah to be afraid and sin so they could give him a bad reputation as the leader and make fun of him. God was using Nehemiah to lead His people to rebuild the walls around Jerusalem.

In Nehemiah 8, when Ezra stands on the wooden platform to read the Word of God and give the "sense" of it, he's preaching to God's people. In exile, they'd wandered far from God. But at the hearing of his Word, they start to weep as they're convicted by God's holy law.

By the end of this book we find him as Nehemiah the Governor of the city - actually overruling in all the affairs, religious and social, within the city. But here in chapter 1, before God calls him in verse one as such, we find him as the cupbearer of the King - King Artaxerxes.
