Pediatric ECG Interpretation. At birth, the right ventricle is larger and thicker than the left ventricle, reflecting the greater physiological stresses placed upon it in utero (i.e. pumping blood through the relatively high-resistance pulmonary circulation).. This produces an ECG picture reminiscent of right ventricular hypertrophy in the adult: marked rightward axis, dominant R wave in V1 ...
