The following notes explore the five stages of reading development as proposed by Maryanne Wolf (2008) in her book *Proust and the squid: the story and science of the reading brain*. These five stages are: the emerging pre-reader (typically between 6 months to 6 years old); the novice reader (typically between 6 to 7 years old); the decoding reader (typically between 7 - 9 years old);

Five Stages of Reading Development — The Literacy Bug

Reading Development Stage 1: Pre-Reading/Emergent Readers. The first and most important stage is when children show an interest in reading and voluntarily pick up a book.
