Orr claims historical developments shape tribal politics in two ways: growing wealth leads to increased self-interest at the expense of social harmony, while historical trauma promotes a “melancholic” world view that “inclines individual and community motivation toward perpetuating grievances, grieving, and reliving trauma to the detriment of self-interest and community harmony” for decades or even centuries after the initial traumatizing event.
