The Role of Freight Forwarders | HIS Spedition
A freight forwarder provides the services required to import and export goods through co-operation with truck companies, shipping lines, and so on. Basically, a shipping line is a company that controls the cargo vessels that provide delivery from the load port to the destination port.

The Role of the Freight Broker in the Shipping Industry ...
Example : Hapag Lloyd, Maersk, China Shipping.. Some of the shipping lines have container services covering most ports of the world, and it is common that they might run into a situation where by they have shortage of containers at certain locations or they might have requirement of certain types of containers (Flat Racks, Open Tops etc) at certain locations..

Difference between Container Owner and Shipping Line
In response to your second question "circumstances where a shipper will be worse of dealing with a Freight Forwarder rather than a NVOCC", this cannot be quantified because in general terms a customer (whether exporter or importer) "appoints" a freight forwarder to act as their agent whereas they "employ the services" of a NVOCC as a carrier same as they would a shipping line..

Role and Function of Freight Forwarders Example | Graduateway
Freight forwarder. Often confused with freight brokers, freight forwarders are actually completely different. Forwarders take possession of the goods, consolidate numerous smaller shipments into one larger shipment, then arrange for transportation of that shipment using various shipping methods (air, water, land). Import-export broker.

Freight forwarder Job Description, Duties, Roles and ...
FCL (full container load) - release notice arrange depending on the shipping line depot agreement and transport agreement, then only then will the container be delivered to consignee. Road freight - all depends on the INCO terms and limitations of the vehicle / site to where the cargo needs to be delivered upon release has been receive.
