Who was Rosa Parks? Rosa Parks was an important figure in the American Civil Rights movement. During the time of segregation on public transport, black people were expected to move and allow white people to sit down on buses. On 1st December 1955, Rosa Parks refused to give up her seat and this sparked a mass movement called the Bus Boycott.
