Shorting stock, also known as short selling, involves the sale of stock that the seller does not own, or shares that the seller has taken on loan from a broker.

Short selling might also be performed by certain options sellers. If they have a short sell position, they are able to write Put contracts against it. For example, imagine the stock is in a slow decline. A trader might short sell 100 shares of a certain stock. Then he might sell Put contracts to earn an income. Know the Rules to Short Selling

A naked short is the shorting of a stock without actually borrowing and selling the shares, what the SEC calls "affirmatively determined to exist." This practice is illegal. When a real short is underway, traders can either borrow shares or determine shares are available to be borrowed before they sell them short.
