And, from the early stages of the movement, German Reformers, like Luther, used these "polemics against sodomy" as a weapon against Rome, which in turn led to "an almost exclusively Protestant discourse" about the spiritual profit of marriage (p. 177).

Thus, Puff proposes how the concept of sodomy, originally defined as sexual "heresy," ultimately transformed into a rhetoric of inclusion and difference creating communal identity in the German-speaking regions of Switzerland and Germany during the Reformation.

In the 14th century, a considerable number of men in Germany and Switzerland were executed for committing sodomy. In the 17th century, simply speaking of the act was cause for censorship. Here, in the first ever history of sodomy in these countries, Helmut Puff argues that accusations of sodomy in this era were actually crucial to the success of the Protestant Reformation.
