In 1970, feminist author, activist, and NOW co-founder Betty Friedan referred to lesbians in the organization as a "lavender menace" in The New York Times Magazine, believing their open presence in the organization would hinder the respectability of the march toward women's rights and make feminist activists look like unsound manhaters. That year, Rita Mae Brown, long known for being vocal and out, was fired from her position as the editor of NOW's newsletter.
