These Regulations are made under the Care Standards Act 2000 ("the Act") and apply to England only. Part I of the Act establishes, in relation to England, the National Care Standards Commission ("the Commission") and Part II provides for the registration and inspection of establishments and agencies, including care homes, by the Commission.

Home Care Aide Certification. On November 8, 2011, the public voted Initiative 1163 (PDF) into law. The new law relates to requirements for long-term care worker training, background checks and certification as home care aides. The new requirements took effect January 7, 2012.
