Their goal was to extract and classify the "higher objectives of law" (maqasid ash-shariah) and thereby to constitute a general philosophy of Islamic law that can be integrated in the production of legal rulings, fatwas and good-manners. The term "maqsid" (plural: maqasid) refers to a purpose, objective, principle, intent, goal, or end.

Sharia (/ʃəˈriːə/, Arabic: شريعة [ʃaˈriːʕa]), Islamic law or Sharia law is a religious law forming part of the Islamic tradition. It is derived from the religious precepts of Islam, particularly the Quran and the Hadith. In Arabic, the term sharī'ah refers to God's immutable divine law and is contrasted with fiqh, which refers to its human scholarly interpretations.

Maqasid is an Arabic word [singular maqsid] which carries the meaning of goals or purposes and when it refers to Shariah [Maqasid Al Sharia] it specifically means the goals and purposes of Shariah. There are three other Arabic words that are found in the relevant literatures of usul al-fiqh that convey similar meaning as maqasid .

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The Higher Objectives of Islamic Law

Further, every objective of the Shari'ah has exceptions. It has limits and controls. For example, preservation of life is one of the most important objectives of the Shari'ah. However, a killer will not be able to hold to this objective and benefit from it to save his own life from capital punishment.
