Response to placebo in placebo-controlled trials was significantly higher in drug-drug-placebo studies compared with drug-placebo studies (46.7% and 32.2%, respectively;  $p=0.002$ ). These meta-analytic results suggest that the design of a clinical trial shapes patients' expectancy of symptom improvement during the trial, which in turn influences response to antidepressant medication and placebo.
