Trauma Systems Therapy TST is a model of care for traumatized children that addresses both the individual child's emotional needs as well as the social environment in which he or she lives. It is about breaking down barriers between service systems, understanding a child's symptoms in the context of his or her world, and building on a family's strengths and dreams.

The purpose of trauma-focused therapy is to offer skills and strategies to assist your child in better understanding, coping with, processing emotions and memories tied to traumatic experiences, with the end goal of enabling your child to create a healthier and more adaptive meaning of the experience that took place in his/her life.
