Examine each F 2 ear of corn to ensure that kernels are not missing. If an ear has a large number of missing kernels, then the ratio of phenotypes could be incorrect. Collect corn ears and store them in a cool dry place for extended use.

If you want to cook the corn at the same time, cook on HIGH heat for 4-5 minutes. Or, If you just want to remove the husk only and not cook the corn, heat the corn for about 2 minutes. If you have more than one ear add 1-2 more minutes per ear.

Place two ears of corn on the cob with the husks in the microwave evenly spaced apart. Microwave two ears of corn on the cob for 3-4 minutes on high. Start with three minutes. Check the corn and continue cooking it in 30-second intervals until hot.

Remove the husk and the silk from each ear of corn. Add 1 cup (240ml) of water to the Instant Pot. Place the metal trivet in the pot, and then add in the ears or corn. Stack two ears on the bottom, and two on top.
