*Unemployment Insurance | U.S. Department of Labor*

A valid work search means you have completed specific work-search activities that may lead to a new job and that can be verified by the Division of Unemployment Insurance. Various factors are considered when determining if the work you are seeking is suitable including, but not limited to, rate of pay, prior experience, and length of unemployment.

*Labor and Economic Opportunity - Unemployment Insurance Agency*

The Unemployment Insurance program provides benefits to workers who are unemployed through no fault of their own and who are able, available, and looking for work. You may file a claim for benefits the first day after becoming separated from employment or after your employer has significantly reduced your work hours.

When you file for unemployment benefits, your initial eligibility for benefits is based on your earnings and your reason for leaving your job. Ongoing eligibility requirements include being able to work, available for work, and actively searching for work.

*Unemployment Guidelines*

Earnings Requirements: To receive unemployment compensation, workers must meet the unemployment eligibility requirements for wages earned or time worked during an established (usually one year) period of time. Also, workers must be determined to be unemployed through no fault of their own, so if you quit or were fired, you may not be eligible for unemployment compensation.

*Colorado CO Unemployment Office List - eligibility*

A: To be eligible for unemployment insurance, you must be ready, willing and able to work, and actively looking for work. You must be ready to start work at once and be physically and mentally capable of working to receive benefits.

While collecting unemployment, you are required to file weekly or biweekly claims detailing your job hunt, job offers, earnings from part-time work, and any times you've refused work (and why).

*Collecting Unemployment Benefits in Ohio | Nolo*

Unemployment compensation (UC) is money paid to workers who have lost their jobs through no fault of their own. Any unemployed person may file a claim for UC benefits. Your eligibility is based on the information provided by you and your employer(s) after you file an application for UC benefits.

*Collecting Unemployment Benefits in Florida | Nolo*

You must meet the weekly eligibility requirements listed below. Your benefit week begins on Sunday and ends at midnight on Saturday. You cannot claim the week until it is completely over. The first week you meet the weekly eligibility requirements will be your waiting period week. You will not receive a benefit payment for the waiting period week.

*Before You Apply For Unemployment - New York State ...*

Unemployment Insurance Agency Michigan's Unemployment Insurance program provides temporary income to workers who have lost their job through no fault of their own. The program is funded through unemployment taxes paid by employers.

*Before You Apply - Wisconsin Department of Workforce ...*

In Florida—as in every other state—employees who are temporarily out of work through no fault of their own may qualify to collect unemployment benefits. The eligibility rules, prior earnings requirements, benefit amounts, and other details vary from state to state, however.

*Eligibility Requirements*

Although the basic rules for unemployment are similar across the board, the benefit amounts, eligibility rules, and other details vary from state to state. Here's how unemployment benefits work in Ohio. How to File a Claim for Unemployment Benefits in Ohio. The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) administers unemployment benefits.

### *How to Tell if You Are Eligible for Unemployment Benefits*

Unemployment Guide This handbook is designed to provide a basic understanding of the unemployment benefit process. The initial processing time for a claim takes four to six weeks, then if it is determined you qualify to receive payment, you are paid every two weeks from a fund paid by employers.

### *Benefits Eligibility | Virginia Employment Commission*

To be eligible for unemployment benefit payments, you must: Lose your job through no fault of your own OR quit for good cause related to the work or the employer. Make at least \$2,250—at least \$1,500 during one of the calendar quarters, and at least \$750 during the remainder of the base period—from an insured employer during your base period.

### *Unemployment Benefits - labor.idaho.gov*

To receive Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefit payments, you must meet all eligibility requirements when filing a claim and when certifying for benefits. Requirements to File a Claim When filing for UI benefits, you must have earned enough wages during the base period to establish a claim, and be: Physically able to work.
