Congress plays a key oversight role in foreign policy and sometimes has direct involvement in foreign policy decisions. An example of direct involvement is the pair of votes in the House and the Senate in October 2002 that authorized President George W. Bush to deploy U.S. military forces against Iraq as he saw fit.
