Corporate law in Vietnam was originally based on the French commercial law system. However, since Vietnam's independence in 1945, it has largely been influenced by the ruling Communist Party . Currently, the main sources of corporate law are the Law on Enterprises, [2] the Law on Securities [3] and the Law on Investment.
